"I think we'll see important jewelry —significant but not blingy," said Pinto, who is attending the inauguration.

Constance White, a New York-based fashion reporter and style director of eBay, doesn't see Obama cutting expense with a mass-market dress brand. So she may temper a glam gown with fabulous but affordable cubic zirconia jewelry, instead of jewels.

"I don't think Americans really want to see their first lady in [a dress from] White House/Black Market on Inauguration Day regardless of the state of their own pocketbooks," White said. "They just don't."
